

## HENLLANFALLTEG COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

Minutes of the Henllanfallteg Community Association held on March 5th 2008 in the Millennium Hall at 7.30 pm

Minutes The minutes of the February 08 meeting were received, approved and signed.

### Matters Arising from the Minutes

- The white board was now in use in the main room. The cost had been £104.68.
- Any spillage from paint used on Friday nights needed to be cleaned up immediately.
- The fire extinguishers had been checked and an invoice received.
- The sub-committee considering hall brochures had not yet been able to meet.

### FINANCE

- It was agreed that Elaine be asked if she would agree to being paid by the Treasurer once a month.
- The Treasurer was authorised to make the monthly payments for cleaning.
- Any envelopes left by Dancers, Yoga etc should be collected and given to the Treasurer at the monthly meeting.
- It was agreed to seek sponsorship for the Newsletter at the current rate of £50 an edition even though the price had gone up. It was decided to check back to see how money held by the Association was ring-fenced for the Newsletter.
- The Treasurer reported that the current account held £1,321.87 and the deposit account £6,362.23.
- The County Council had booked the hall for Tuesday evening Welsh classes until July and were keeping up the payments.
- The Whitland Male Voice Choir Evening had raised £208. A donation of £50 had been given to the choir for expenses.
- The Association was of the view that this year's fete proceeds should go to the Playing Field Association.
- The chairman was chasing the Pembrokeshire craft people to pay for their hire of the hall.
- The Playing Field Association was planning this year to repay the loan to the Community Association.

### HALL PAINTING TENDERS

Four had been received. These were opened and the tenders were for £1490, £1695, £3264 and £6932. It was decided to accept the tender from Dave Owen for £1695 subject to the references he had supplied being checked by the chairman.

### DISPLAY BOARDS

John Spencer reported that the History Society had received a grant in the region of £500 for the purchase of display boards mainly for use in the hall. It was suggested that if the Community Association was considering buying display boards then they should match up with the History boards. It was agreed that the Association should spend a similar amount.

### HORSE RACING NIGHT

Arrangements were made for the function on April 26th. Sponsorship was needed from local firms and individuals for 10 races with prizes costing around £10. Tickets would be £4 which included a horse and refreshments (caul etc). Tickets would encourage race-goers to bring their own drinks or collect from the pub.

#### OTHER MATTERS

- Whitland Aikido Club was looking for a new venue. If it wished to use the hall on a Tuesday evening (or possibly a Sunday) it was agreed that the cost would be £10.
- Peter Icke reported that he had given out 96 of the 200 low energy light bulbs for pensioners.
- Open Gardens was provisionally arranged for Sunday 6th July.

The meeting closed at 8.55 pm.
